

1 **RESOLUTION NO. 20190808-0XX**

2 **WHEREAS**, the City of Austin seeks to restore the Brush Square – O.
3 Henry Museum building (Project); and

4 **WHEREAS**, expenditures for the Project will exceed \$50,000; and

5 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Local Government Code Section 252.021(a),
6 before entering into a contract that requires an expenditure of more than
7 \$50,000.00, the City must: (1) comply with Subchapters B and C of Chapter 252,
8 Local Government Code (Chapter 252) related to competitive bidding and
9 proposals; (2) use the reverse auction procedure defined by Section 2155.062(d) of
10 the Government Code, for purchasing; or (3) comply with a method described by
11 Chapter 2269 of the Texas Government Code (Chapter 2269); and

12 **WHEREAS**, Subchapter D of Chapter 2269 - “Competitive Sealed Proposal
13 Method” describes the competitive sealed proposal method authorized by that
14 subchapter as a project delivery method by which a governmental entity requests
15 proposals, ranks the offerors, negotiates as prescribed, and then contracts with a
16 general contractor for the construction, rehabilitation, alteration, or repair of a
17 facility; and

18 **WHEREAS**, Section 2269.056(a) of the Government Code provides that the
19 governing body of a governmental entity that considers a construction contract
20 using a method authorized by Chapter 2269 other than competitive bidding must,
21 before advertising, determine which method provides the best value for the
22 governmental entity; and

23 **WHEREAS**, in relation to the Project specifics and requirements, staff has
24 considered the methods described in Chapter 2269 and reviewed the procedures
25 described in Chapter 252; and

26 **WHEREAS**, with respect to the Project and the expenditures necessary to
27 complete it, staff recommends the use of the Competitive Sealed Proposal Method
28 authorized by Subchapter D, Chapter 2269, Government Code as the project
29 delivery method that provides the best value for the City;

30 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF**
31 **THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

32 The City Council finds that with respect to expenditures necessary for the
33 Brush Square – O. Henry Museum Restoration Project to restore the museum
34 building, the competitive sealed proposal method described by Subchapter D of
35 Chapter 2269 of the Texas Government Code provides the best value for the City.
