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WHEREAS, the owners of the properties listed and attached to this resolution as Exhibit A have applied for a partial exemption from ad valorem taxes levied by the City; and

WHEREAS, City of Austin staff have reviewed the applications for partial exemption from ad valorem taxes have inspected these properties and reviewed records to confirm that these properties are being preserved and maintained as required by the City's historic landmark regulations; and

WHEREAS, Council approved an interlocal agreement with the Austin Independent School District on March 22, 2012, in which the City agreed to share a Council approved list of properties that had met these initial requirements to be considered for partial tax exemption by the City; and

25 **WHEREAS**, the City Council may, concurrent with the annual tax levy,
26 annually approve partial exemptions from ad valorem taxes for certain properties
27 designated as historic; **NOW, THEREFORE**,

28 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

29 The City Manager is authorized to include in his budget calculations for the
30 coming year partial exemptions from ad valorem taxes, as allowed by City Code,
31 for the properties listed and attached to this resolution as Exhibit A.

32 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

33 The City Manager is authorized to provide this resolution, including Exhibit
34 A, to the Austin Independent School District; and

35 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

36 The City Manager is authorized to prepare an ordinance approving partial
37 exemptions from ad valorem taxes levied by the City for these listed properties and
38 to present this ordinance for council's consideration concurrently with council's
39 consideration of the annual tax levy.
