ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: CAMPO has awarded the project federal funding under the Surface Transportation Program Metropolitan Mobility program in amount up to \$11,240,000. A City funding match of \$3,900,000 is required and is available in the FY 2018-2019 Austin Transportation Capital Budget. In addition, Austin Water is providing funding of \$2,260,000 for relocation and new utilities. Final grant and local match funding amounts are dependent upon actual costs of implementation of this project. Project design and implementation is managed by the Austin Transportation Department.
