What is the Purpose of the Agreement?

This is an interlocal agreement between the City of Austin and Austin Community College in which the City of Austin provides an occasional meeting space at the Oakwood Cemetery Chapel.

- The City of Austin recognizes the importance of education in understanding of human nature and the values of human life and supports Austin Community College in teaching the Great Questions Courses.
- The recently remodeled Chapel's Mission:
 - Through historical tours, exhibits, events and memorial services, the Oakwood Cemetery Chapel provides a place to connect, heal and reflect, that is open to all. The lives that built Austin are at Oakwood Cemetery. We are united here in search of love, life and meaning.

Who Does the Program Serve?

How Will the Funds be Allocated?

No funds will be exchanged for these activities.

What is the Term of the Agreement?

The initial term for this agreement is October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2020 and will be renewed automatically on the anniversary date for five successive 12-month terms subject to Austin City Council appropriation.

What Services and Deliverables will The PARD Provide?

- PARD will provide set-up, break down, and custodial service for the space.
- PARD will communicate with ACC staff regarding scheduling and related event details.
