*TDHCA's definition of Supportive Housing includes the provision of substantial on-site services to the resident population, which primarily includes the homeless or those at-risk of homelessness.

**Section 811 Project Rental Assistance program provides project-based rental assistance for extremely low-income people with disabilities linked with comprehensive supportive services.

Target populations include:(1) people with disabilities living in institutions; (2) people with serious mental illness; and (3) youth with disabilities exiting foster care.

***Continuum of Care (CoC) units are coordinated by ECHO and provide either Rapid Rehousing or Permanent Supportive Housing for people experiencing chronic homelessness. Residents are prioritized through the Coordinated Assessment.
