

RESOLUTION NO. 20190808-034

WHEREAS, Officer Ryan Hancock of the Austin Police Department was injured on July 21, 2017 by carbon monoxide exposure while performing his official duties and operating a City of Austin Ford Police Interceptor; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Act provides for up to one-year of absence at full pay for police officers injured in the line of duty; and

WHEREAS, Officer Hancock has been on a leave of absence at full pay, since July 21, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Act authorizes a municipality's governing body to extend a police officer's leave of absence for a line of duty injury after the initial one-year period has expired,; and

WHEREAS, on June 28, 2018, the council approved Resolution 20180628- 119 extending Officer Hancock's leave of absence for an additional year at full pay until July 21, 2019;and

WHEREAS, Officer Hancock has not returned to duty and his leave of absence expires on July 21, 2019; **NOW, THEREFORE**,



BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

The leave of absence for Officer Ryan Hancock's July 21, 2017 line of duty injury, authorized by Section 143.073 of the Texas Local Government Code, is hereby extended, at full pay, beyond July 21, 2019. This extension shall cover additional

periods of leave necessitated by Officer Hancock's July 21, 2017 injuries, up to a maximum of six (6) months of additional leave until January 21, 2020.
