

PROJECT CONNECT LONG-TERM VISION

- NOTES**
- 1) Artist rendering of potential in blue, orange, red, yellow, green, purple, blue, and grey. Not a final plan or technical drawing of engineering and construction details.
 - 2) Autonomous connected electric technology may be applied to BRT or LRT or even bus rapid transit as well as to other transit modes.
 - 3) BRT Light rail corridors are a near-term solution. Long-term application is to advance BRT light rail corridors to full BRT or a dedicated pathway.
 - 4) The completion of the Bay Area is dependent upon major development needed to connect transit to the region.
 - 5) Capital-Intensive Connections Study: Potential regional connections to San Antonio.



PROPOSED PROJECT AT A GLANCE


- The proposed Orange Line would be a **north/south transit line**.
- Would provide **high-capacity service within dedicated transitways**.
- Would establish the **north/south link** to the broader Project Connect system.
- Would **operate along the existing 801 route**.

- Would establish a **link** to the broader Project Connect system and major activity centers.
- Would operate along portions of the existing Routes **7, 10 and 20**.


LOOKING AHEAD
