

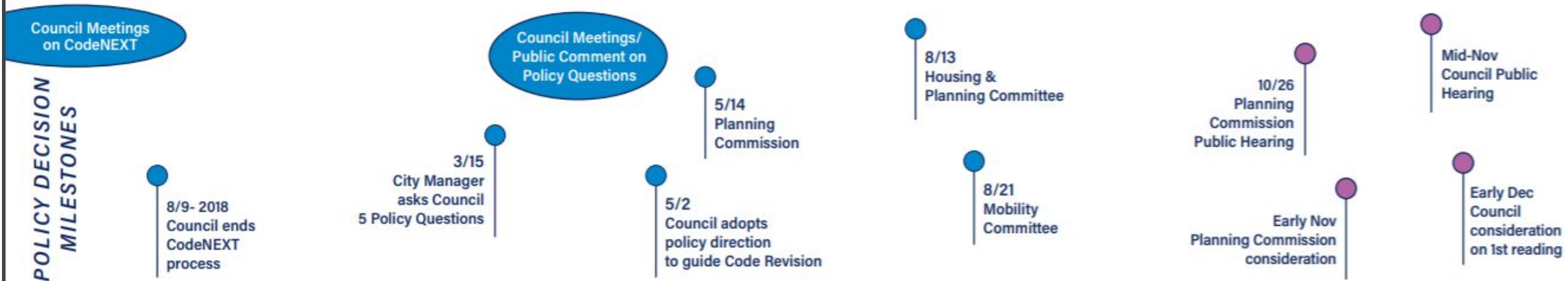
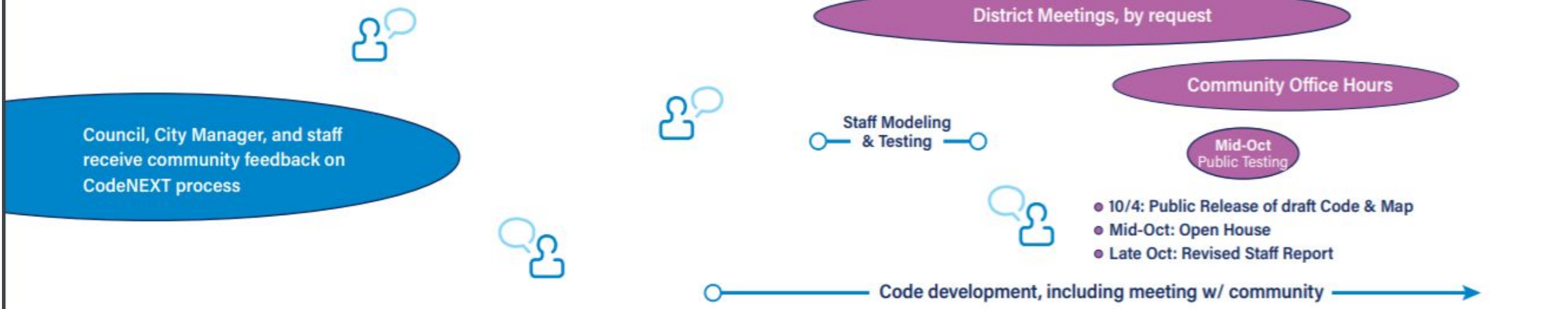

\*Proposed dates, subject to change based on Council direction & outcome of public process

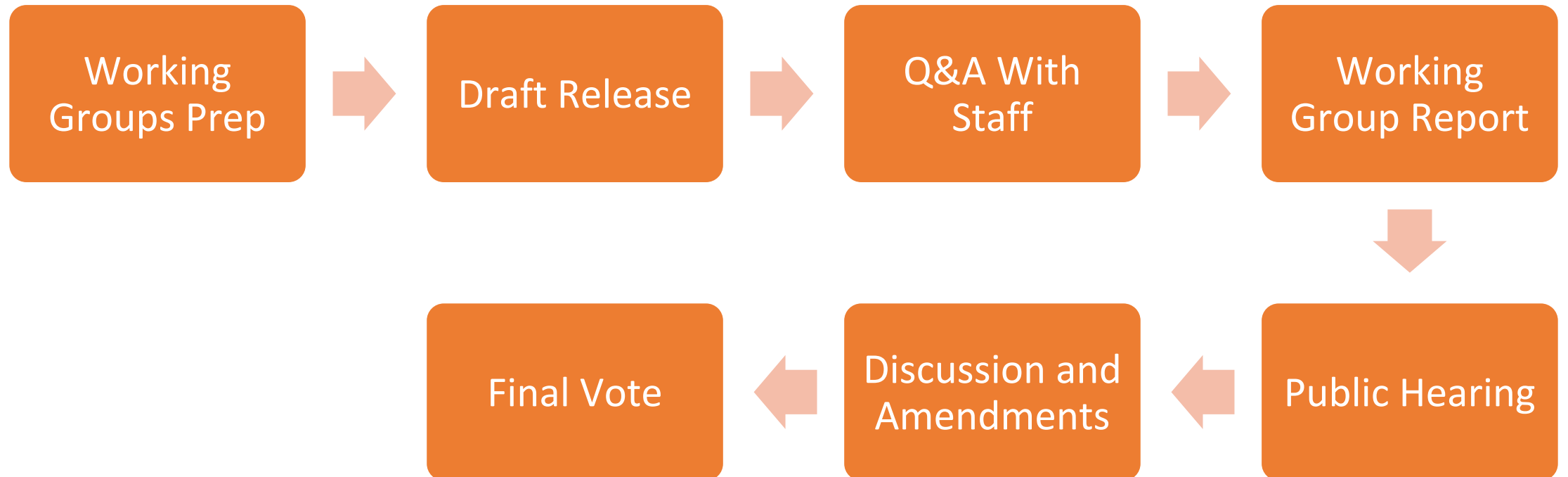


# Key Dates From City Manager

# Process



# Charge to the Working Groups

## Before the draft is released

- Review policies, metrics and targets found in City Council’s “Direction in Response to City Manager’s March 15, 2019 Memo re:Land Development Code Revision Policy Guidance” and Austin’s Comprehensive Plan and determine which ones are key to evaluating the LDC. Remember, Imagine Austin is only one part of the plan. The plan also includes Austin Strategic Mobility Plan, the Strategic Housing Blueprint, etc.
- Determine the process by which you’ll evaluate the new code against these policies, metrics and targets.
- Detail any data that you will need for evaluation and work with staff to plan how you will collect that data.

## After the draft is released

- Evaluate how well the draft met policies, metrics and targets within Council’s direction and Comprehensive Plan.
- Assess how draft prioritizes among competing objectives
- Develop a list of possible amendments

# Considerations and Amendments

- Commissioners should attempt to submit proposed amendments to staff in time for posting with agenda to allow maximum time for review
- Commissioners should attempt to keep amendments as general direction to staff on how to improve draft before final reading
- Commission will consider motions from Commissioners in round robin order until all are heard, or the Commission decides to end consideration by a vote of 2/3
- Executive Committee will then make further amendments as needed to clarify the intent of the commission
- Commission will take a final vote on the draft as amended
- Commission will deliver vote tally on all amendments to Council as part of recommendation
