






Residential Incentive Program Participation






Commercial & Multifamily Incentive Program Participation






Incentives Budget and Expenditures, FY19 YTD



 - 1,722 Processed


- Administrative Fines assessed:

Public Outreach Activity Number of Events




Public Outreach Activity Populations Reached






Social Media Activity, FY19 TD






Reclaimed Water






Total Peak Water Savings, Gallons Per Day (GPD)






WATER USE - GALLONS PER CAPITA PER DAY (GPCD)





Total Cumulative Water Savings Projected for FY 2019





Daily Water Usage August 2019






Multi-Year Daily Water Usage
