


**Basic Facts About Caminos Teen Leadership Program at ESB-MACC**

CAMINOS is an immersive; one year long paid internship empowering Austin-area Teens to carve their own path in the creative arts. Students work alongside ESB-MACC professionals on a variety of community oriented activities, projects, and exhibitions. This year, the MACC partnered with Gensler Architecture where the teens learned about architecture firms.
