**AN ORDINANCE ADJUSTING THE CITY OF AUSTIN'S BOUNDARY LIMITS BY DISANNEXING APPROXIMATELY 20 ACRES OF LAND LOCATED AT THE INTERSECTION OF US HIGHWAY 290 EAST AND GILES LANE FROM THE CITY'S FULL-PURPOSE JURISDICTION AND RELEASING THE LAND FROM THE CITY'S EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

**PART 1. Findings.**

- (A) Texas Local Government Code Section 43.142 authorizes a city to disannex an area in accordance with the city's charter. The Austin City Charter, Article I, Section 6, provides that the City may disannex an area after a public hearing. A public hearing to disannex the area generally located at the northwest corner of US Highway 290 East and Giles Lane was held on October 17, 2019, in the City Hall Council Chambers, 301 W. 2<sup>nd</sup> Street, Austin Texas.
- (B) Texas Local Government Code Section 43.023 authorizes a city to reduce its extraterritorial jurisdiction by giving written consent by ordinance or resolution. Austin City Charter, Article I, Section 6, provides that the City may reduce its boundary by ordinance.

**PART 2.** The boundary limits of the City are amended to exclude, and the City of Austin disannexes and releases from its full-purpose jurisdiction and extraterritorial jurisdiction, approximately 20 acres of land more particularly described in **Exhibit “A”** attached to and incorporated as part of this ordinance.

**PART 3.** This ordinance takes effect on \_\_\_\_\_, 2019.
