Austin Energy will report back to Council by October 15, 2020, on the results and impacts of Council authorization of spending for Austin Energy rebate programs for multifamily and commercial properties energy efficiency upgrades. The report must be discussed by Council before similar authorization in FY2020-21 can be made. This report should include, at a minimum:

- Year-over-year comparisons of multifamily and commercial properties applying for and receiving energy efficiency rebates, highlighting low and low-to-moderate income multifamily property weatherization rebate applicants and recipients.
- Breakdown and analysis of rebate applicants and recipients by Council district, and comparison of FY2019-20 recipients to prior years by Council District, to include descriptive statistics about rebate amount and communities served by participating recipients.
- Analysis of the impacts of full-year authorization versus the previous process of authorization on a project-by-project basis, with emphasis on any impacts on equity.

Austin Energy is directed to provide monthly reports throughout FY2019-20 to the Electric Utility Commission, Resource Management Commission, and to the Austin Energy Utility Oversight Committee about projects approved for rebates, projects in the pipeline for approval, year-to-date amounts spent on rebates, and project fact sheets for all projects.
