4. POTENTIAL CODE AMENDMENTS: Proposed for Discussion and/or InitiationPotential amendments to the code are offered for discussion and/or possible recommendation for initiation. If initiated, Staff will research the proposal and report back to the subcommittee.

a. Residential Uses in the Airport Overlay. Discuss and consider initiation of an amendment to Title 25 (25-13-45) that would remove residential uses from the list of allowable uses in the A0-3 zone of the Airport Overlay. Mark Walters presented an amendment that would prohibit residential uses in the AO-3 airport overlay zone. Currently the Montopolis neighborhood is the only area with residential uses in the AO-3 zone.

A motion was made to recommend the item to Planning Commission by Commissioner Duncan, seconded by Commissioner Denkler. Vote: 5-0 (Commissioners Kazi, Barrera-Ramirez absent).

b. Downtown Density Bonus. Discuss and consider initiation of amendments to Title 25 of the City Code related to 25-2-586 (B) Downtown Density Bonus Map and Table to correct a mapping discrepancy. City Staff: Jorge E. Rousselin, Planning and Zoning Department, (512) 974-2975, Jorge.Rousselin@austintexas.gov; (Discussion and/or Possible Action).

Jorge Rousselin presented an amendment to correct a boundary error in the downtown density bonus program (DDBP) map. The map currently bisects a property that should be fully included within the DDBP map.

A motion was made to recommend the item to Planning Commission by Commissioner Duncan, seconded by Commissioner Schissler. Vote: 5-0 (Commissioners Kazi, Barrera-Ramirez absent).

a. University Neighborhood Overlay. Consider amendments to Title 25 for regulations governing development in the University Neighborhood Overlay (UNO) related to density bonuses and increased building heights, reduced parking standards, allowable uses, and signs. Mark Walters presented an amendment to make a suite of changes to the University Neighborhood Overlay, including changes to uses, height, and parking requirements.
