Authorize negotiation and execution of all documents and instruments necessary or desirable to purchase in fee simple a tract of land totaling approximately 4.695 acres out of the Thomas Anderson League, in Travis County, Texas, located at 4349 Convict Hill Road from Venturina Biggs for a total amount not to exceed \$509,000, including closing costs. Additional Backup Information:

Whirlpool Cave is the third largest of the 62 federal permit Balcones Canyonland Conservation Plan caves. Acquisition will include the majority of the cave and is required for federal permit compliance to allow required land management over the cave preserve. The land and underlying cave also provide recharge to Barton Springs, based on prior tracing from this site. There is no unanticipated fiscal impact. The 1996 federal permit (PRT-78841) directs that the highest priority for the mitigation fund be preserve acquisition.

The purchase price of \$490,000.00 is the current fair market value as determined by an independent third party appraiser. The purchase price plus closing cost is in the amount not to exceed \$509,000.00.
