Additional Backup Information:

The contract will provide steel utility poles for Austin Energy's Oak Hill Substation to Patton Lane Substation Circuit 969 rerouting project for the Texas Department of Transportation. In compliance with a Utility Relocation Agreement with the State of Texas through the Texas Transportation Commission, Austin Energy will provide new steel poles and adjust, remove, and/or relocate its poles. The Utility Relocation Agreement

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includes adjustments and reimbursement provisions that will allow Austin Energy to recoup the cost of the poles.
