ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: This grant amendment appropriates an additional \$49,981 in grant funds for a total grant award of \$1,249,981 for fiscal year 2020. This grant is the first of several large floodplain study updates based on the Atlas 14 rainfall data that will be initiated in fiscal years 2020 and 2021. These studies will result in new floodplain models and maps for all streams within City of Austin jurisdictional area. The General Fund will not be required to contribute additional funds beyond those currently budgeted to this grant. When the grant funds expire, Watershed Protection Department's need for continuing funding will be evaluated and may be denied.
