## DRAFT - Proposed Process for LDC Adoption

## 1) December 7 – Pass First Reading of staff's revised proposed approach

- a. All Councilmembers may ask for direction from staff to come back with options
- b. All direction will be adopted, no votes taken on direction
- c. The direction must be within the scope of Policy Direction adopted in May in the view of the Councilmember (include citation of the sections of the Direction)
- d. Direction may address
  - i. Policy matters not addressed in the Code
  - ii. Policy matters where Councilmember thinks were not interpreted by staff within meaning of the Direction
  - iii. Policy matters where staff's proposal doesn't achieve policy direction results in the view of the Council member
- e. An example of direction might be: Direct City Manager to propose additional options for achieving more affordable units along corridors, to include options for maintaining VMU standards for minimum affordable units and options for accepting voluntary contributions of affordable housing units

## 2) Mapping

- a. December 7 map not passed on first reading, not addressed
- b. Councilmembers must submit all map changes by deadline (mid January?)
- c. Mapping to be handled on consent and presented as total map
  - i. Council Members may pull individual parcels off consent, keeping in mind the goals for Council District unit capacity
- d. Map passed in February
