- **Objective:** Staff to brief UTC on the Jan 2019 – Sept 2019 [E-bikes and E-scooters on Austin Trails Pilot Program](#) + resulting staff recommendations shared for electric scooter use on parkland:
 - *Revise city code to allow electric scooters on limited paved parkland trails*
 - *Continue geofencing and improve its effectiveness*
 - *Designate parking box areas*
 - *Create a culture of shared trails with etiquette campaign*
 - *Set trail speed limits*

- **Time-sensitivity:** Staff recommendations will likely be considered by City Council in early 2020
- **Additional info:** Austin Transportation, Austin Public Works, and Austin Police are partners on this pilot
