WHEREAS, during Fiscal Year 2019-2020, the City may receive one or more grants, including amendments from previously accepted grants, from the Federal Aviation Administration, the Department of Homeland Security, and other state and federal agencies, for the operation, improvement, noise mitigation, and security of the Austin-Bergstrom International Airport; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

The City Manager, the Director of the Department of Aviation, or their duly 12 authorized designees, are authorized retroactively and prospectively to: (a) accept 13 one or more grants, including amendments to previously accepted grants, from the 14 15 Federal Aviation Administration, the Department of Homeland Security, and other 16 state and federal agencies, for the operation, improvement, noise mitigation, and security of the Austin-Bergstrom International Airport, in a total aggregate amount 17 not to exceed \$30,000,000 in Fiscal Year 2019-2020 on such terms and conditions 18 as may be necessary, appropriate, or required by law providing that the grant 19 obligations do not conflict with any approved Council Ordinance (collectively, 20 21 "Authorized Grants"); (b) sign and execute the Authorized Grants; and (c) perform

Grants in accordance with this Resolution.
