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2	WHEREAS, the City of Austin seeks to authorize the 2020 Job Order				
3	Contract for City of Austin Facility Improvements to award job order assignments				
4	for facility maintenance, repair, alteration, renovation, remediation, or minor				
5	construction of City facilities; and				
6	WHEREAS, expenditures for the Project will exceed \$50,000; and				
7	WHEREAS, pursuant to Local Government Code Section 252.021(a),				
8	before entering into a contract that requires an expenditure of more than				
9	\$50,000.00, the City must: (1) comply with Subchapters B and C of Chapter 252,				
10	Local Government Code (Chapter 252) related to competitive bidding and				
11	proposals; (2) use the reverse auction procedure defined by Section 2155.062(d) of				
12	the Government Code, for purchasing; or (3) comply with a method described by				
13	Chapter 2269 of the Texas Government Code (Chapter 2269); and				
14	WHEREAS, Subchapter D of Chapter 2269 - "Competitive Sealed Proposal				
15	Method" describes the competitive sealed proposal method authorized by that				
16	subchapter as a project delivery method by which a governmental entity requests				
17	proposals, ranks the offerors, negotiates as prescribed, and then contracts with a				
18	general contractor for the construction, rehabilitation, alteration, or repair of a				
19	facility; and				
20	WHEREAS, Section 2269.056(a) of the Texas Government Code provides				
20					
21	that a governmental entity may use the competitive sealed proposal method under				
22	Subchapter D for job order contracts; and				

WHEREAS, Section 2269.056(a) of the Texas Government Code provides 23 that the governing body of a governmental entity that considers a construction 24

contract using a method authorized by Chapter 2269 other than competitive
bidding must, before advertising, determine which method provides the best value
for the governmental entity; and

WHEREAS, in relation to the Project specifics and requirements, staff has
considered the methods described in Chapter 2269 and reviewed the procedures
described in Chapter 252; and

WHEREAS, with respect to the Project and the expenditures necessary to complete it, staff recommends the use of the Competitive Sealed Proposal Method authorized by Subchapter D, Chapter 2269, Government Code as the project delivery method that provides the best value for the City;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

The City Council finds that with respect to expenditures necessary for the 2020 Job Order Contract for City of Austin Facility Improvements, the competitive sealed proposal method described by Subchapter D of Chapter 2269 of the Texas Government Code provides the best value for the City.
