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contract using a method authorized by Chapter 2269 other than competitive bidding must, before advertising, determine which method provides the best value for the governmental entity; and

**WHEREAS**, in relation to the Project specifics and requirements, staff has considered the methods described in Chapter 2269 and reviewed the procedures described in Chapter 252; and

**WHEREAS**, with respect to the Project and the expenditures necessary to complete it, staff recommends the use of the Competitive Sealed Proposal Method authorized by Subchapter D, Chapter 2269, Government Code as the project delivery method that provides the best value for the City;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

The City Council finds that with respect to expenditures necessary for the 2020 Job Order Contract for City of Austin Facility Improvements, the competitive sealed proposal method described by Subchapter D of Chapter 2269 of the Texas Government Code provides the best value for the City.
