ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A COMPREHENSIVE REVISION TO THE LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE RELATING TO THE REGULATION OF LAND USE AND DEVELOPMENT IN THE CITY OF AUSTIN AND ITS EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION AND PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. Legislative Findings.

The City Council adopts the following findings:

- (A) The Planning Commission held a public hearing on October 26, 2019, regarding the draft Land Development Code. After deliberating at multiple meetings, on November 12, 2019, the Planning Commission voted on its recommendations on the draft revised Land Development Code.
- (B) The final Planning Commission report was forwarded to City Council on November 22, 2019.
- (C) The City Council, after receiving the Planning Commission's report, conducted a public hearing on December 7, 2019, and thereafter began its deliberations.
- (D) The public hearings and notifications provided for the Land Development Code Revision, as well as the Planning Commission's report to Council, satisfy all applicable requirements of state law, the City Charter, and City Code.
- (E) The revised Land Development Code furthers the goals and objectives of the City's Comprehensive Plan and is in the interest of the public health, safety, and welfare.

PART 2. Adoption of New Land Development Code.

(A) The Land Development Code, attached hereto as Exhibit A-1 and incorporated herein by reference, is hereby approved and adopted as Title 23 of the City Code. The Zoning Map reflecting Title 23 is attached and incorporated as Exhibit A-2.

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- (2) make suggestions.
- (D) Notwithstanding the timeline described in Section 1-2-9 (*Failure to Adopt a Rule*), the initial proposed rule must be adopted on or before the 90th day after the notice of proposed rule is posted by the City Clerk.
- (E) Subsequent amendment of the initial administrative rule is subject to standard city rulemaking processes.

PART 5. Codification.

In codifying Title 23 and any subsequent amendments thereto, code sections, subsections, and paragraphs may be renumbered and reformatted as appropriate to ensure consistency within the Land Development Code and with the numbering and formatting of the City Code.

PART 6. Legislative Record.

The legislative record for this ordinance includes, but is not limited to:

- (A) All documentary and testimonial evidence provided or referenced in connection with the public hearings and deliberations conducted by the Planning Commission and the City Council, as identified in Part 1 of this ordinance; and
