



FY20 YTD Water Waste Enforcement Activity


















Annual Amount of Water Diverted for Municipal Use (Acre-feet)

Upcoming Events

- February 15 Spring application period begins for Landscape Survival Tools Rebate:
 - \$50 for at least 2 cubic yards (54 cubic feet) of compost
 - \$40 for at least 2 cubic yards (54 cubic feet) of mulch
 - \$30 for core aeration service of entire front and/or back lawn
 - Application period ends June 15.
