7 8 9 10 11 12	Council finds that amendments to Chapters 10-4 ( <i>Minors' Access to Tobacco</i> ) and 10-11 ( <i>Electronic Smoking Devices</i> ) of Title 10 ( <i>Public Health Services and Sanitation</i> ) of the City Code are necessary to ensure consistency with recently adopted Federal law relating to the lawful age for the sale or delivery of cigarettes, tobacco products, or electronic smoking devices.
13 14 15	<b>PART 2.</b> The definition of "minor" in City Code Section 10-4-1 ( <i>Definitions</i> ) is amended to read as follows:
16	(1) MINOR means a person under [18] 21 years of age.
17 18	<b>PART 3.</b> Subsection (B) of City Code Section 10-4-11 ( <i>Sale or Delivery to Minor Prohibited</i> ) is amended to read as follows:
19	(B) To comply with this section, proof of identification must:
20 21	(1) be issued by the department of public safety or another governmental agency;
22 23	(2) contain a photograph or physical description consistent with the appearance of the individual presenting the proof; and
24	(3) establish that the individual is $[18]$ 21 years of age or older.
25 26	<b>PART 4.</b> The definition of "minor" in City Code Section 10-11-1 ( <i>Definitions</i> ) is amended to read as follows:
27	(1) MINOR means a person under [48] 21 years of age.
28 29	<b>PART 5.</b> Subsection (B) of City Code Section 10-11-4 (Sale or Delivery to Minor Prohibited) is amended to read as follows:
30	(B) To comply with this section, proof of identification must:  Page 1 of 2
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31 32	(1) be issued by the department of public safety or another governmental agency;
33 34	(2) contain a photograph or physical description consistent with the appearance of the individual presenting the proof; and
35	(3) establish that the individual is $[18]$ 21 years of age or older.
