- 363 acres
- Constructed drainage channel
 Country Club West
- Original drainage channel –
 Country Club East
- Park& Channel Improvements constructed in 2010





Erosion Damage

- 2015 Floods
- Severe erosion created a shorter path to the river.
- Pedestrian bridge collapsed
- May 2015 December 2017:
 Erosion damaged
 ~1500 feet (5 acres)
 of drainage channel
- 100s of trees lost
- Equivalent of 2500 dump truck loads of sand and soil lost (~37,000 cubic yards)






ROY G. GUERRERO PARK CHANNEL STABILIZATION
