February 10, 2020 - Recommended unanimously by the Electric Utility Commission on an 8-0 vote, with Commissioners Collier-Brown, Funkhouser, and Stone absent.

Additional Backup Information:

The contract will provide eight online transformer monitors for Austin Energy's Dessau Substation. The monitors obtain real time temperature values of oil inside of transformers which provide details of cooling equipment operations. The implementation of these monitors will assist Austin Energy in maximizing the life of the transformers with the ability to see real-time data to allow for preemptive maintenance. Advanced Power Technologies LLC is the sole provider and owns three patents on the device.
