Approve the negotiation and execution of a loan agreement and related documents with Blackshear Neighborhood Development Corporation, or an affiliated entity, in an amount not to exceed \$128,600, for the rehabilitation of three single family properties, to be known as Leona and Concho, to be located at 1130 Leona Street, 1132 Leona Street, and 1107 Concho Street.
