SUBJECT:	Update Regarding Resolution No. 2019	91205-062

The purpose of this memo is to provide you an update on Resolution No. <u>20191205-062</u>, which directed the City Manager to prepare a report about the City's restriction on consuming alcoholic beverages on public streets or sidewalks within certain areas in Austin.

Additionally, the City Manager's Office must provide recommendations on whether the areas of the City where public consumption of alcoholic beverages is prohibited should be amended or reduced, recognizing that the applicable sections of Chapter 4-9 must comply with section 109.35 of the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Code.

Upon completion of the report, the Public Safety Commission is directed to review the report and make recommendations to Council.

Status Updates

The Council directed the City Manager to provide an update on progress of this report by February 2020. The Municipal Court and Austin Police Department are currently working on gathering data. We anticipate the Law Department and City Manager's Office to have their analysis of the data completed by April 22, 2020; therefore, we request an extension.

We anticipate a final report will be provided to the Public Safety Commission by May 1, 2020.
