The City Council hereby ratifies the disaster declaration signed by Mayor Steve Adler on March 6, 2020, and consents to its continuation <u>indefinitely</u> for a period of thirty days, and such disaster declaration is hereby continued through April 5<sup>th</sup>, or until such time as it is terminated by order of the Council.
