ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The Texas Department of State Health Services, Community Preparedness Section, is allocating \$1,697,986 in additional grant funds to perform required and allowable activities in support of the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) response. The funding will be used for a new amendment contract term of March 15, 2020 through March 15, 2021. The grant allows for preaward costs estimated at \$38,080 for medical supplies, general supplies and printing and postage. The remaining funding of \$1,659,906 includes funds for temporary personnel and additional medical supplies, communication and other costs.

The General Fund will not be required to contribute additional funds beyond those currently budgeted to this grant. When the grant funds expire, the Austin Public Health Department's need for continuing funding will be evaluated and may be denied.
