







COVID-19 Policy Implementation Dates vs Symptom Onset Dates




Austin/Travis County COVID-19 New Cases by Week


Self-Assessment and Testing Recommendation

Scheduling


Individuals recommended for testing choose a test location, set an appointment and receive a unique QR code to expedite check-in.
