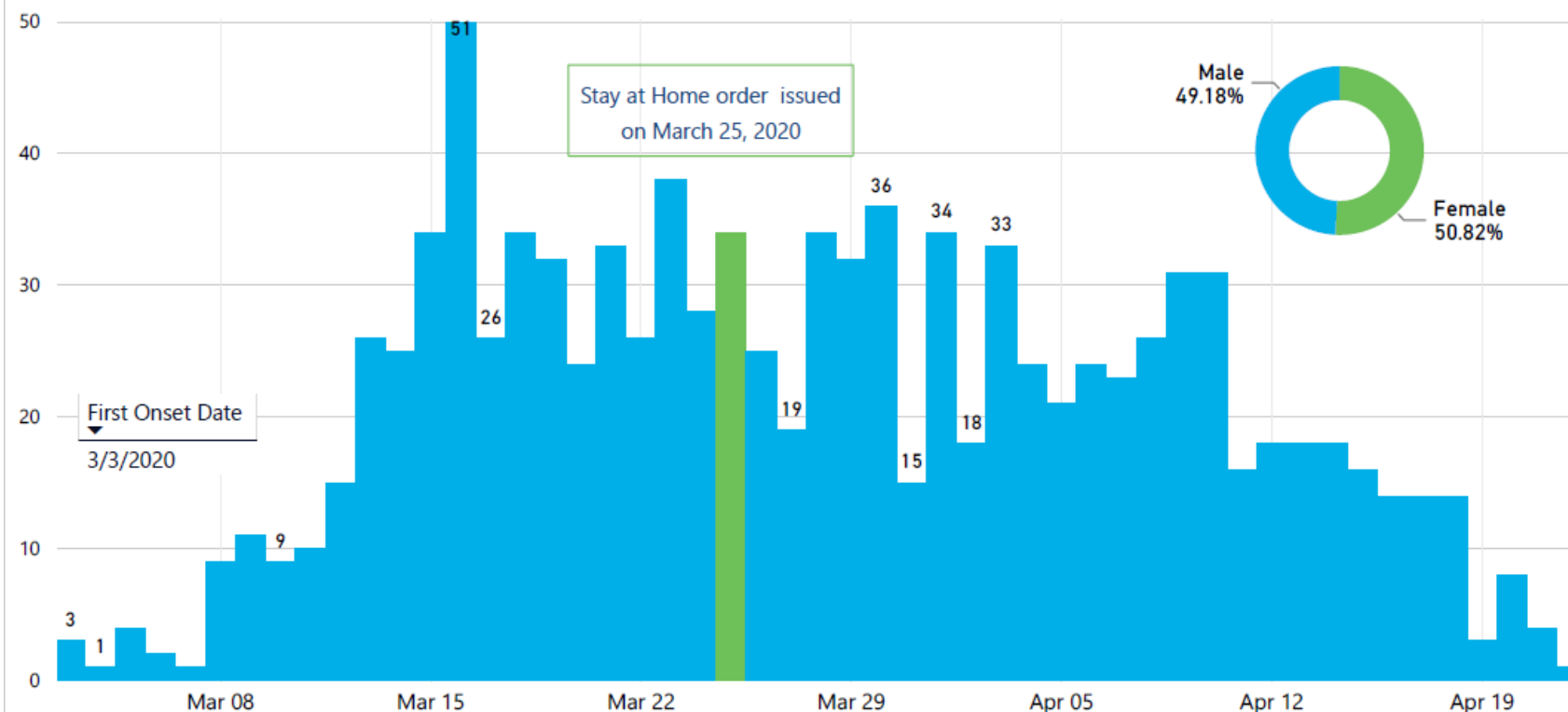

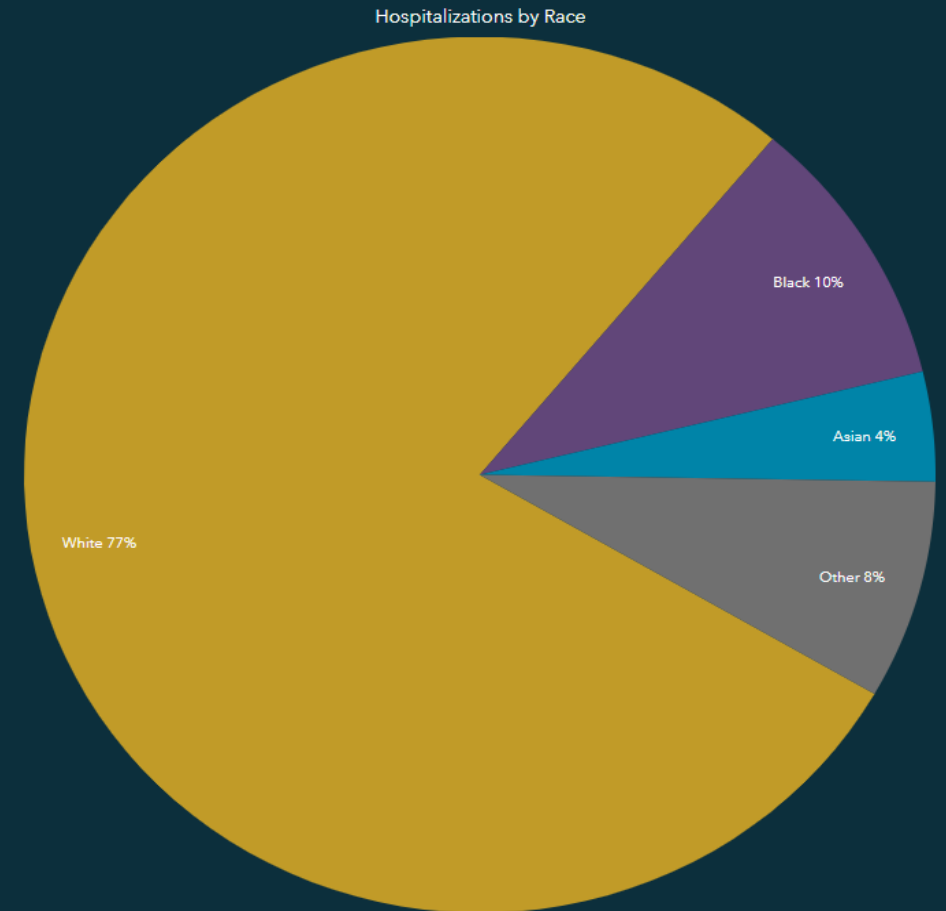

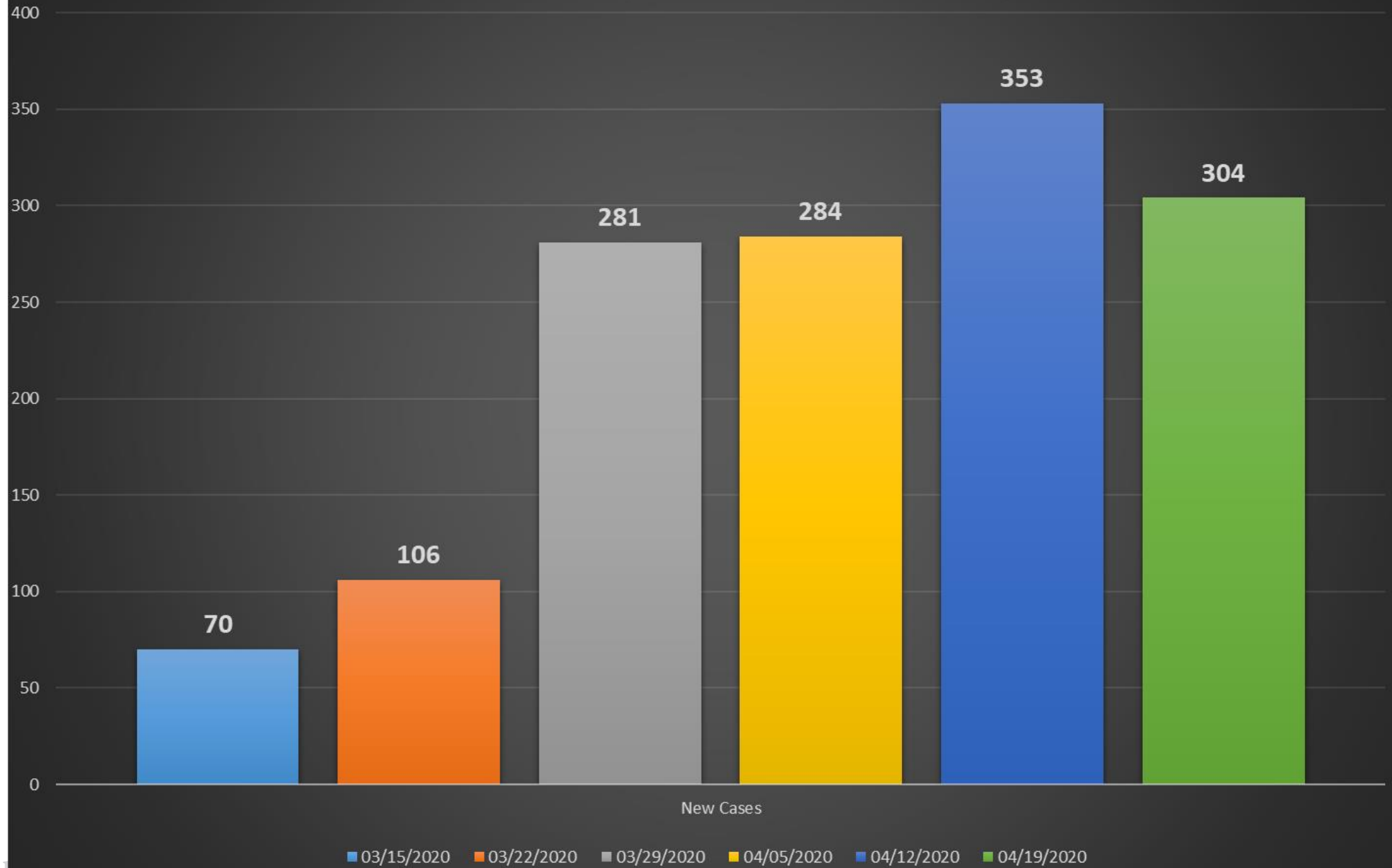
Travis County hospitalizations with discharges from March 1, 2020 through April 22, 2020.

# City of Austin-Travis County COVID-19

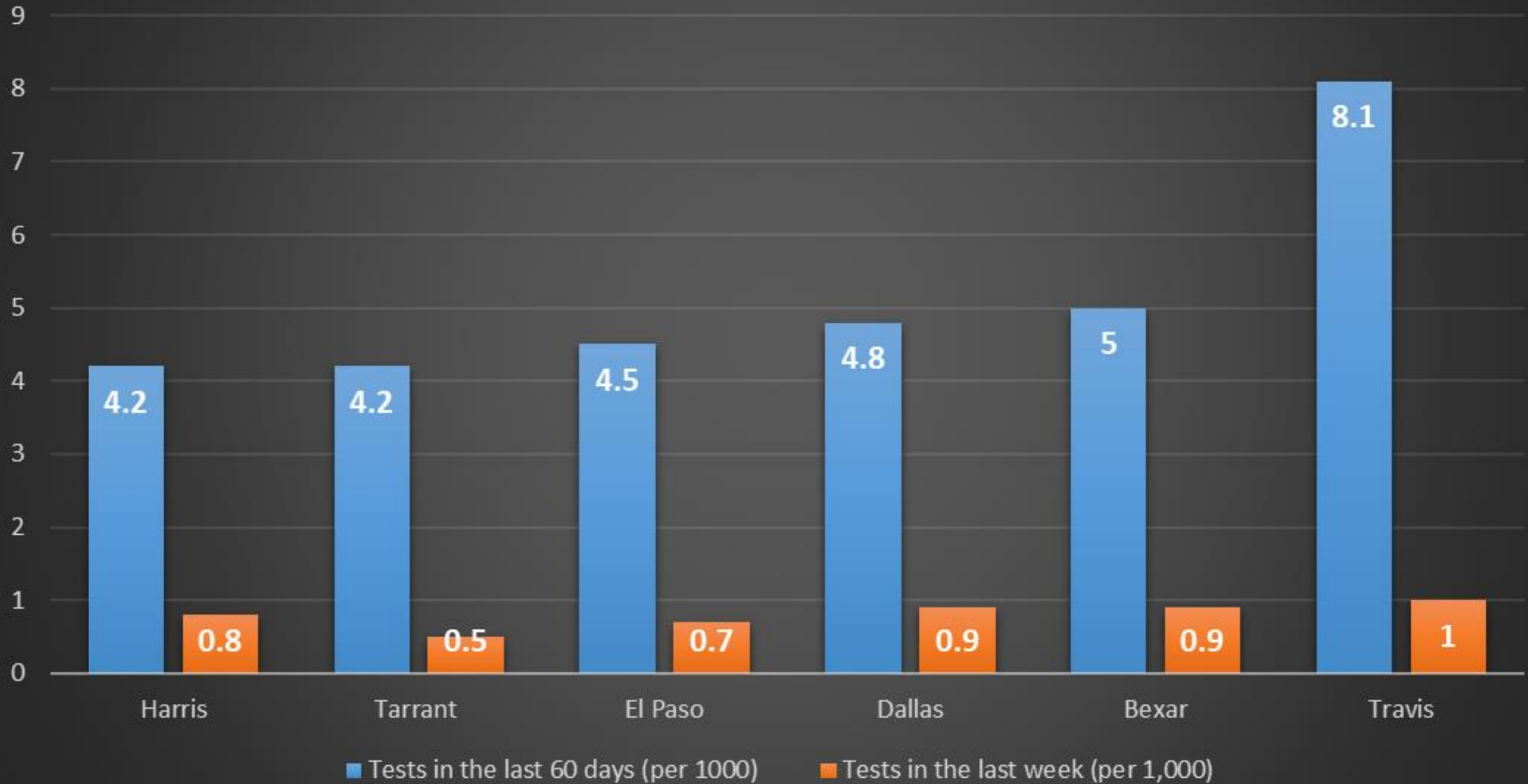


## Austin/Travis County COVID-19 New Cases by Week

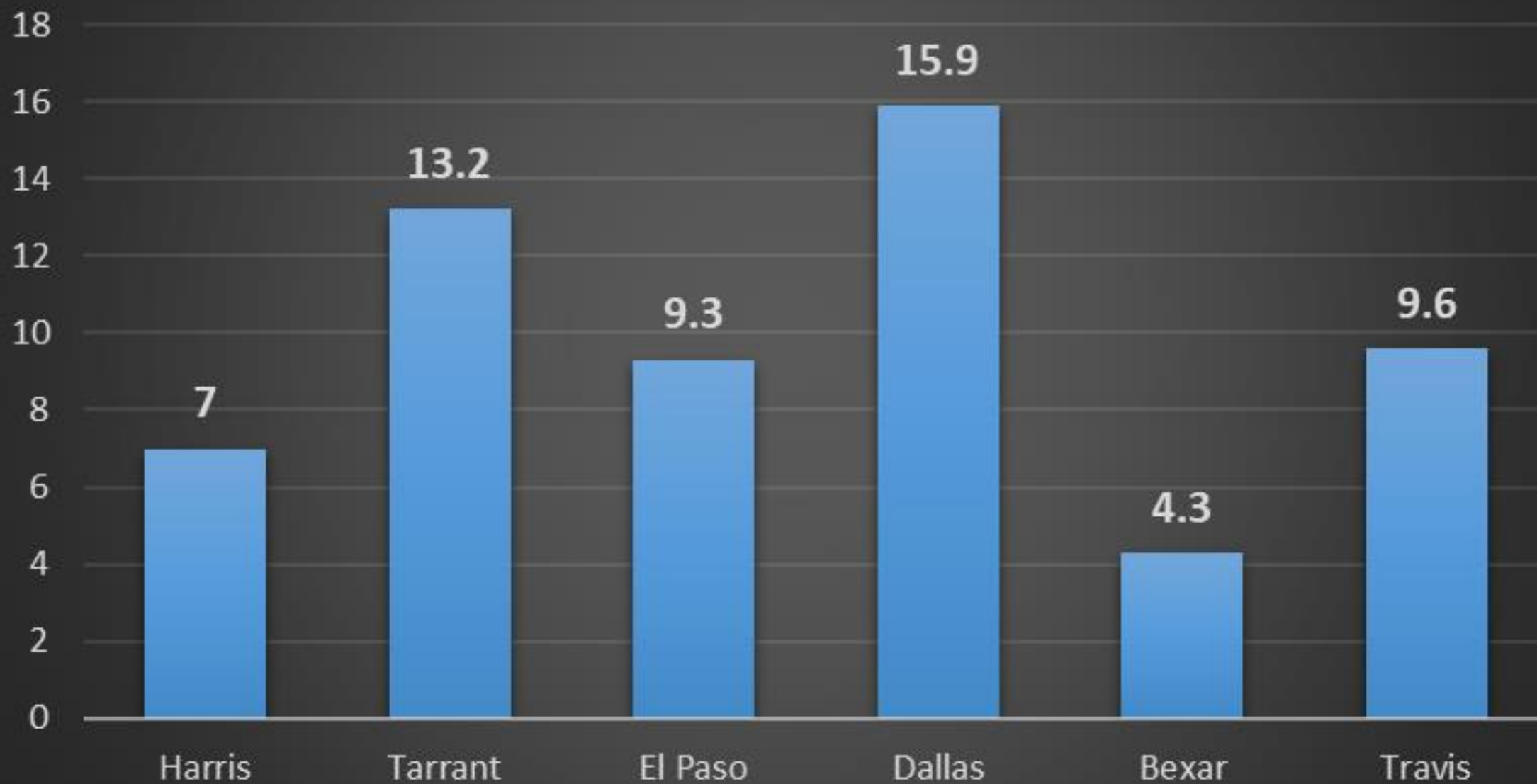


# COVID-19 Testing By County

## CV19 Lab Testing Dashboard

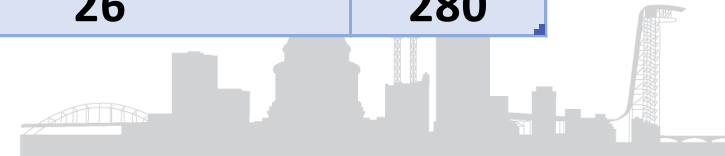

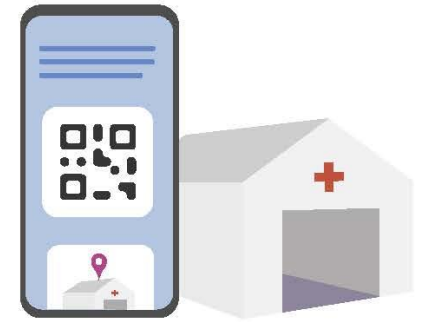
### Self-Assessment and Testing Recommendation

### Scheduling

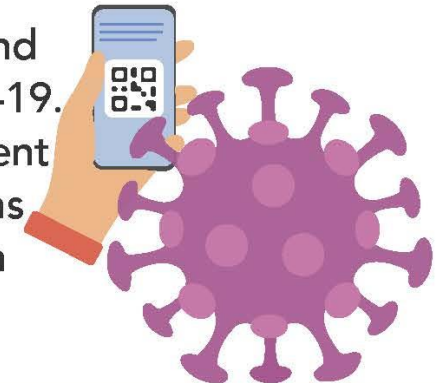
Individuals recommended for testing choose a test location, set an appointment and receive a unique QR code to expedite check-in.

Individuals check-in and are tested for COVID-19. Individuals are then sent results and instructions on next steps through the secure portal.
