# Posting Language

Approve an ordinance amending the Fiscal Year 2019-2020 Austin Public Health Department's Operating Budget Special Revenue Fund (Ordinance No. 20190910-001) to accept and appropriate \$147,845 in grant funding from the U.S. Department of Health & Human Services, Health Resources and Services Administration, to implement the grant deliverables for the Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program Part-C Early Intervention Services COVID-19 Response.

#### Fiscal Note

Funding in the amount of \$147,845 is available from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Health Resource and Service Administration. The Fiscal Year 2019-2020 Ryan White HIV/AIDS Part-C contract period is March 1, 2020 through February 28, 2021. Funding for the COVID-19 response is limited to the dates listed and will expire on March 31, 2021. A City funding match is not required. A fiscal note is attached.

# Additional Backup Information:

The goal of the grant is to assist efforts at reducing the spread of COVID-19 among people living with HIV. This is a one-year non-renewable grant that started April 1, 2020 and will conclude on March 31, 2021. The funds are stipulated to be used to control the spread of COVID-19 and assist those in needs related to the COVID-19 pandemic.

The General Fund will not be required to contribute additional funds beyond those currently budgeted to this grant. When the grant funds expire, the Austin Public Health Department's need for continuing funding will be evaluated and may be denied.
