ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: This action will accept and appropriate \$170,811,898 from the United States (U.S). Federal Government Coronavirus Relief Funds. This funding will be utilized in accordance with federal guidelines. The Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act requires that the payments from the Coronavirus Relief Fund only be used to cover expenses that:

- (1) are necessary expenditures incurred due to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19);
- (2) were not accounted for in the City budget most recently approved as of March 27, 2020 (the date of enactment of the CARES Act) for the State or government; and
- (3) were incurred during the period that begins on March 1, 2020, and that ends on December 30, 2020. Additionally, the expenditures must meet the requirements of the U.S. Department of the Treasury, or the funds must be repaid to the U.S. government. These guidelines can be found at:
