21	Property Crimes Lieutenant as the project director who will continue and manage
22	the APD Auto Burglary and Theft Interdiction Project; and

24	WHEREAS, the City Council has agreed that in the event of loss or misuse
25	of these Texas Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority grant funds, the City
26	Council assures that the funds will be returned to the Texas Motor Vehicle Crime
