

**RESOLUTION NO. 20200521-097**

**WHEREAS**, the City is currently a party to an interlocal agreement with the Texas Department of Public Safety to participate in a program operated by OmniBase Services of Texas, which places holds on driver license renewals when individuals miss court or payments on Class C misdemeanors until the tickets are completely resolved; and

**WHEREAS**, individuals who are unable to renew their licenses due to the OmniBase program often become trapped in a cycle of debt when they must continue to drive in order to resolve their tickets and provide for their families, thereby risking more tickets and holds for driving without a valid license; and

**WHEREAS**, the OmniBase program is optional, and jurisdictions that choose not to participate have similar collection rates to those that do; and

**WHEREAS**, the City's interlocal agreement for participation in the OmniBase program expires July 16, 2020, will not automatically renew, and will require Council action to be renewed; and

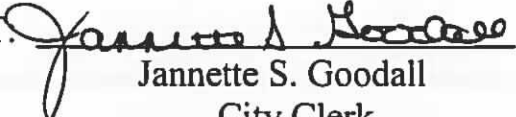
**WHEREAS**, the OmniBase program is contrary to the City's goals of advancing economic mobility and fair administration of justice; **NOW, THEREFORE,**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

The City Manager is directed to not renew the current interlocal agreement with the Texas Department of Public Safety for participation in the OmniBase program when it expires.
