### **Additional Backup Information:**

This resolution is to approve the COVID-19 proposed spending framework. The City of Austin is eligible for funding from several recent acts of federal legislation passed to provide financial relief for municipalities addressing the COVID-19 pandemic, including all of the various categories of funding within the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, & Economic Security (CARES) Act. Council has also directed use of local funds to the extent necessary to address the priorities for the community that may not be eligible to be funded with federal funds.
