

- 37 women operating under a state or national organization and used exclusively
38 for that purpose, including property owned by the Austin Independent School
39 District;
- 40 (F) property owned by an institution of purely public charity, as identified by the
41 Travis Central Appraisal District records;
- 42 (G) property used primarily for a recreational, park, or scenic purpose during the
43 calendar year immediately preceding the effective date of this ordinance;
- 44 (H) property owned by a utility that is located in public streets or rights-of-way;
- 45 (I) property used as a residence that fits the definition of a homestead in Section
46 41.002 of the Texas Property Code;
- 47 (J) property owned by The University of Texas and the State of Texas;
- 48 (K) all hospitals; and
- 49 (L) the first \$500,000 in valuation of property liable for assessment.

50

51 **PART 4.** Property designated by the city as “H” Historic is assessed on the basis of
52 the value prescribed in City Code Section 11-1-22 (*Determination of Exemption*
53 *Amount*).

55 **PART 5.** The City Council approves the attached Exhibit A, as the proposed
56 calendar year 2021 assessment roll for the District.

58 **PART 6.** The provisions of this ordinance are severable. If any provision of this
59 ordinance or its application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the
60 invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of this ordinance.
