Street Impact Fee Study results and draft policy recommendation: Liane Miller, Austin Transportation Program Manager, gave a <u>presentation</u> regarding <u>Street Impact Fee</u> study results and draft policy recommendations, including work to date, prior actions, Maximum Impact Fee recommendation, Draft Policy recommendation, community feedback and next steps.
