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- WHEREAS, the City is eligible for \$13,585,307 in federal grant funds,
- 4 including Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Home Investment
- 5 Partnerships Program (HOME), Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS
- 6 (HOPWA), and Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG) from the United States
- 7 Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for Fiscal Year (FY) 2020-
- 8 21 (collectively, the "Federal HUD Grant"); and
- 9 WHEREAS, the City's proposed Fiscal Year 2020-2021 Community
- 10 Development Program and annual Action Plan will use the Federal HUD Grant and
- 11 local funding; and
- WHEREAS, in accordance with Texas Local Government Code Section
- 13 373.006(1), (2), and (3), the City Council:
- 1. identified in its Fiscal Years 2019-2024 Consolidated Plan, adopted on
- June 6, 2019, areas of the municipality in which predominantly low- and moderate-
- income persons reside, or that are blighted or slum areas; and
- 2. established in its Fiscal Years 2019-2024 Consolidated Plan, adopted on
- June 6, 2019, community development program areas in which community
- development activities, building rehabilitation, or the acquisition of privately-owned
- buildings or land are proposed; and

- 3. adopted a Citizen Participation Plan (CPP) under which residents may publicly comment on proposed community development programs and the annual Action Plan (Resolution No. 960328-31, amended by Resolution No. 000113-29, amended by Resolution No. 040129-8, amended by Resolution No. 20111215-089, and amended by Resolution No. 20200521-014); and
- WHEREAS, in accordance with Texas Local Government Code Section 373.006(4) and Part 91, Title 24 of the Code of Federal Regulations, the City Council conducted public hearings on April 23, 2020 and July 30, 2020, to obtain public comment on the proposed Action Plan; and
- WHEREAS, in accordance with Texas Local Government Code Section 373.006(4) and Part 91, Title 24 of the Code of Federal Regulations, on July 15, 2020, the Community Development Commission conducted a public hearing to obtain public comment on the proposed Action Plan and made its final recommendation on the proposed Action Plan; and
 - WHEREAS, the City made the proposed Action Plan available for a 15-day public comment period beginning on July 15, 2020; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

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The City Council approves the Fiscal Year 2020-21 Action Plan (attached to this resolution and identified as Exhibit A) and related Funding Table (attached to this resolution and identified as Exhibit B).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

The City Council authorizes the City Manager to submit and execute the necessary grant applications, certifications, and other related documents including, but not limited to, applications, a final statement of community development objectives, and projected use of funds; and to negotiate, as necessary, with HUD for the Federal HUD Grant.
