SUBJECT:	Changing the Map for Teen Pregnancy Prevention Tier 1 (Council item no. 47 – July 29, 2020 Council Agenda)

This memo pertains to item #47 on the July 29, 2020, to approve an ordinance amending the Fiscal Year 2019-2020 Austin Public Health Department's Operating Budget Special Revenue Fund (Ordinance No. 20190910-001) to accept and appropriate \$837,000 in grant funds from the Office of the Assistant Secretary for Health, Office of Population Affairs for Optimally Changing the Map for Teen Pregnancy Prevention Tier 1 in Austin-Travis County.

This funding will be used to create and support the Del Valle Healthy Adolescent Project (DVHAP), which is a three-component intervention developed by Austin Public Health's Austin Healthy Adolescent (AHA) Program and the DVHAP partner organizations. The organizations that make up the Core Del Valle Healthy Adolescent Program (DVHAP) partners include: AHA, The University of Texas Health Science Center School of Public Health (also known as UTHealth), SAFE Alliance (also known as SAFE), Integral Care, El Buen Samaritano, the Travis County Adolescent Health (also known as TCAH) Collaborative, and Nicole Trevino Consulting.
