




#### **Budget Amendment Process**

- Budget adoption proceeding begin August 12





#### **Reimagining Public Safety**

Council Approved Two Resolutions Directing Reductions to the Austin Police Department's FY 2021 Base Budget:

- Eliminated 100 vacant police officer positions
  - Removed 30 positions called for in police staffing plan
  - Cut 70 vacant positions that could not reasonably be filled in FY 2021
- Delayed the July 2020 cadet class
- Delayed scheduled replacement of duty weapons
- Transferred Austin Center of Events staff to Development Services Department

Total reductions of \$11.3 million



#### **Reimagining Public Safety**

# Resolutions Directed Funding be Reallocated To Alternative Approaches to Public Safety:

- \$3.0 million to enhance work of the Office of Police Oversight and Equity Office, rewrite APD's General Orders, and conduct and implement audits
- \$2.7 million to improve mental health first response
- \$2.3 million reallocated within APD to replace records management system
- \$1.1 million to Austin Public Health for mental health services, immigrant legal services, and family violence prevention programs
- \$1.0 million transfer to Housing Trust Fund
- \$900,000 reallocated within in APD to fund training related to trauma-informed response, racial and cultural sensitivity, and use of Naloxone for drug overdoses
- \$300,000 to support the newly formed Civil Rights Office
