# Two Versions of the New Plan

## Brief Version

- Less than 20 pages
- Pictures and Colors
- Accessible and readable
- Translated into Spanish, Vietnamese, Simplified Chinese
- Summarizes major concepts and points but not all the details on strategies

## Full Version

- 100 pages
- Lightly designed
- Figures, Graphs, and Charts
- Full goals, strategies, and “how we’ll get there”
- All the details
- Extensive Appendix
