Policies, Guidelines, and Safety Practices

Due to Health and Safety Concerns regarding COVID-19, The Millennium Youth Entertainment Complex modified, enhanced, and prepared our facility entertainment activity operating procedures and communications to meet the guidelines provided by local and national entities.

Social Distancing

- A-frames, spacing and directional floor markers, and additional signage will be placed to promote social distancing.

Face Mask/Screenings

- Face Mask will be required for patrons, vendors, and employees throughout all events.
- Employees and patrons will be screened prior to entering the building each day.

Cleaning and Sanitation

- Between sessions, the venue will close to engage in proper cleaning and sanitation.
- During the event, bathroom attendants will clean and enforce distancing.
- Select toilets/urinals will be closed.
- Water fountains will be closed.
- Sanitation stations will be placed through the building in high-touch areas (ATM, concessions lines).
- Doors affixed in an open position.

Food and Beverage

- Service staff will wear disposable gloves and face mask at all times.
- Plexiglass installed at order windows.
- Condiment stations removed, and individually packaged condiments will be made upon request.
- Pull up napkin dispensers will be placed at each order pickup location.
- Disposable flatware packaged and handed out with orders.
- Food orders placed on counter not directly handed to the guest.
- All concessions surfaces sanitized at least once per hour.

ALL CUSTOMERS WEAR FABRIC FACE COVERINGS



PER CITY AND COUNTY ORDER, ALL CUSTOMERS MUST BE WEARING A FACE COVERING

Cloth face coverings should—



- fit snugly but comfortably against the side of the face
- be secured with ties or ear loops
- include multiple layers of fabric
- allow for breathing without restriction
- ability to be laundered

Fabric face coverings are not a substitute for physical distancing measures. Continue to maintain 6-feet when outside your home.

EMPLEADOS CUBIERTAS DE TELA PARA LA CARA



POR ORDEN DE LA CIUDAD Y DEL CONDADO, TODOS LOS EMPLEADOS DEBEN USAR CUBIERTAS FACIALES.



Las cubiertas de tela para la cara deben:

- ser cómodas pero quedar bien ajustadas a los lados de la cara
- asegurarse con tiras de amarre o elásticos alrededor de las orejas
- incluir múltiples capas de tela
- permitir respirar sin restricción
- ser lavables en la lavadora de ropa

Las cubiertas de tela para la cara no son un sustituto para las medidas de distanciamiento físico. Continúe guardando 6 pies de distancia cuando esté fuera de su casa.

WE'RE PROTECTING OUR FOOD SERVICE PROVIDERS FROM COVID-19

PREVENT THE SPREAD OF COVID-19

Take your temperature, stay home if your fever is 99.6°F or higher



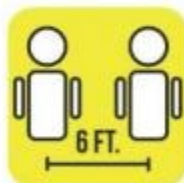
Wash your hands often with soap and water for 20 seconds
