SPECIAL CALLED MEETING THURSDAY, JULY 9, 2020

The City Council of Austin, Texas, convened in a special called meeting on Thursday, July 9, 2020 via. video conference.

Briefing and discussion on matters related Covid-19.
 Briefing was given by Dr. Mark Escott, Interim Health Officer, Austin Public Health;
 Lauren Meyers, PhD, Professor of Integrative Biology, University of Texas at Austin;
 Stephanie Hayden, Director, Austin Public Health.

Direction was given to staff to create a strike team or task force to address concerns and needs of the immigrant communities.

ITEMS FROM COUNCIL

Discussion and possible action on an ordinance declaring a site that fails to meet certain standards
designed to prevent the transmission of COVD-19 between humans as a nuisance, authorizing
civil enforcement, and declaring an emergency. Council Sponsors: Mayor Steve Adler, Council
Member Gregorio Casar, Council Member Kathie Tovo, Council Member Paige Ellis, Mayor Pro
Tem Delia Garza.

Ordinance No. 20200709-002 was approved on Council Member Casar's motion, Council Member Harper-Madison's second on an 11-0 vote.

3. Discussion and possible action on an ordinance authorizing the health authority to adopt rules to protect individuals from COVID-19, creating an offense and penalty, and declaring an emergency. Ordinance No. 20200709-003 was approved on Council Member Casar's motion, Mayor Pro Tem Garza's second on an 11-0 vote.
