Pursuant to Section 11.3 and 11.4 of Texas' 2020 Qualified Allocation Plan, the
City Council acknowledges that the proposed Development is located in a census tract
that has more than 20% Housing Tax Credit Units per total households.

Pursuant to Section 2306.6703(a)(4) of the Texas Government Code and Sections 11.3 and 11.4 of Texas' 2020 Qualified Allocation Plan, the City Council supports the proposed Development; approves the construction of the Development; authorizes an allocation of Housing Tax Credits for the Development; and affirms that the Development is consistent with the City's obligation to affirmatively further fair housing. **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**
