#### Additional Backup Information:

On September 22, 2016, the City Council authorized the creation and incorporation of the Austin/Travis County Sobriety Center Local Government Corporation (LGC) and approved the LGC's Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws. The primary purpose of the LGC is to staff, manage, and operate the sobriety center for the safe short-term treatment and management of intoxicated persons. To amend its Articles of Incorporation, the LGC must file with the City Council of the City of Austin and Travis County Commissioners Court an application

requesting permission to amend the Articles of Incorporation, specifying in the application the amendment proposed to be made.

On September 9, 2020 the Board of the Austin Travis County Sobriety Center LGC (dba The Sobering Center) voted to add a representative position from the Travis County Sheriff's office. This resolution gives permission from the City Council to the LGC to amend its Articles of Incorporation to add the representative from the Travis County Sheriff's Office.
