## **HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION MINUTES**

**REGULAR MEETING  
MONDAY, August 24, 2020**

The Human Rights Commission convened in a regular meeting on Monday, August 24, 2020 via teleconference in Austin, Texas.

Chair Sareta Davis called the Board Meeting to order at 1:00 p.m.

### **1. APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

- a. The minutes from the regular meeting of July 29, 2020 were approved on a vote of 8-0: Chair Davis motion, Commissioner Garry Brown second. Voting in favor were Chair Davis, Vice Chair Jamarr Brown, Commissioner Breckenridge, Commissioner Garry Brown, Commissioner Caballero, Commissioner Griffith, Commissioner Santana, and Commissioner White. Commissioner Casas, Commissioner Museitif, and Commissioner Weigel were absent.

### **2. NEW BUSINESS**

- a. Discussion and possible action on recommendation to Require the Mayor of Austin Appoint a Democratically Elected Chief of Police. (White/Caballero/Weigel).

The Commission discussed this item. The Commission worked informally to finalize the recommendation. The recommendation was adopted on a vote of 6-1-1; Commissioner White motion, Commissioner Griffith second. Voting in favor were Chair Davis, Commissioner Breckenridge, Commissioner Caballero, Commissioner Griffith, Commissioner Santana, and Commissioner White. Voting against was Commissioner Garry Brown. Vice Chair Jamarr Brown abstained.

  - iii. Health Access & Nutrition
