2	WHEREAS, in 1988, Resolution No. 880421-22 authorized an agreement			
4	between the City and the Southwest Texas Council of American Youth Hostels,			
5	Inc. d/b/a Hostelling International (AYH), for the purpose of establishing an AYH			
6	chartered hostel at the Town Lake Boathouse, 2200 S. Lakeshore Drive; and			
7	WHEREAS, in 2012, Resolution No. 20120301-050 authorized Hostelling			
8	International - Austin to continue to occupy the building at 2200 S. Lakeshore			
9	Drive for a period of at least ten years, and encouraged additional concessions to			
10	be added to the property; and			
11	WHEREAS, also in 2012, Resolution No. 20121206-036 waived			
12	requirements of the City's policy for establishing concessions on parkland for a			
13	concession agreement between AYH and EpicSUP LLC (EpicSUP) for a food and			
14	beverage and a stand-up paddle board concession located at 2200 S. Lakeshore			
15	Drive; and			
16	WHEREAS, in 2103, the City and American Youth Hostels, Inc., d/b/a			
17	Hostelling International-USA entered into a license agreement licensing AYH's			
18	continued use of the Town Lake Boat House, 2200 S. Lakeshore Drive, as a youth			
19	hostel; and			
20	WHEREAS, the 2020 pandemic resulted in economic disruption for many			
21	business nationwide, including businesses like AYH, which after 32 years at the			

Town Lake Boathouse, has quietly shut down its business locally and nationally, 22 including terminating its license agreement with the City effective October 31, 23 2020, two years in advance of the agreement's January 1, 2023 expiration date; and 24 **WHEREAS**, the concession agreement between AYH and EpicSUP expired 25 on October 31, 2020, and because AYH is now out of business, the agreement 26 cannot be renewed and EpicSUP is no longer authorized to operate the food and 27 28 beverage and stand-up paddle board concession at 2200 S. Lakeshore Drive; and **WHEREAS**, the premature closure of the AYH youth hostel located in the 29 Town Lake Boathouse has directly affected an Austin small business and limited 30 the recreation options for the community of Southeast Austin; and 31 WHEREAS, The Trail Foundation, a local non-profit which has a long-32 standing history in Austin Communities, serves as a partner with the Parks and 33 Recreation Department and the Austin Public Works Urban Trails Program partner 34 for the Butler Hike and Bike Trail, and works towards meeting mobility, safety, 35 and recreational needs for a fast growing Austin community; and 36 WHEREAS, the City recognizes the value that EpicSUP has brought to the 37 Southeast Austin community through promotion and service of recreational 38

activities; NOW, THEREFORE,

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BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

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The requirements of City Code §§ 8-1-14 and 8-1-71, which establish the

procedures for operating a concession in Lady Bird Lake Park, are waived for a

concession agreement between The Trail Foundation and EpicSUP LLC for a food

and beverage and a stand-up paddle board concession to be located at 2200 S.

Lakeshore Drive, such agreement to have an expiration date of January 1, 2023;

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

Upon expiration of the concession agreement between The Trail Foundation and EpicSUP LLC., the City Manager is directed to consider whether to continue with concession operations at 2200 S. Lakeshore Drive, and if so, to follow applicable purchasing guidelines to secure future concession operations; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

The City Manager is directed to report back to Council on or before April 1, 2021 regarding the City's efforts to facilitate negotiation and execution of a concession agreement between The Trail Foundation and EpicSUP LLC and the proposed timeline for possible future concession solicitation; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

The City Manager is directed to grant a temporary concession permit, valid for up to six months, to EpicSUP and to waive the concession permit fee for
