

AUSTIN CITY COUNCIL MINUTES SPECIAL CALLED MEETING THURSDAY, OCTOBER 29, 2020

The City Council of Austin, Texas, convened in a special called meeting on Thursday, October 29, 2020, via. Videoconference.

Mayor Adler called the Council Meeting to order at 6:01 p.m.

ITEM FROM COUNCIL

1. Approve a resolution initiating rezoning of the property generally located at 2412 Kramer Lane to zone the portion of the property needed for an electric substation to public (P) zoning district, and initiating an amendment to the North Burnet Gateway Regulating Plan to remove the portion of the property rezoned.

A motion to approve the resolution, with the following direction, was made on Mayor Adler's motion, Council Member Ellis' second.

The direction was to have staff bring the zoning case back to Council as soon as possible.

The following amendment was offered by staff and accepted without objection. The amendment was to amend the first Be It Resolved clause to read:

"The City Council initiates the rezoning of the property generally located at 2412 Kramer Lane to zone the property as needed for an electric substation to (P) zoning district, and initiating an amendment to the North Burnet Gateway Regulating Plan to remove the portion of the property rezoned."

Resolution No. 20201029-001 was approved, as amended above, on Mayor Adler's motion, Council Member Ellis' second on a 10-0 vote. Council Member Pool abstained.

Mayor Adler adjourned the Council Meeting at 6:41 p.m. without objection.
